## Your question: Is it the right decision to move to the seaside - and if so, when?"

I created a tarot spread to suit your situation and meditated on your question while I shuffled the cards. Then I laid the cards and this is what they told me:




What will happen if I stay where I am?

This is such a positive reading. It does suggest moving, especially to the coast, as you have two 'Cups' cards, which signify water. The Cups are about our feelings and creative pursuits - and along with the two Major Arcana cards in the spread (signifying major life themes and events) I feel this could be a major emotional turning point in your life.

### What will happen if you stay where you are?

The World is the last Major Arcana card and means completion. It's a wonderful card of success, but could suggest your life in [REDACTED] is completed. It advises bringing things in your life to completion - projects, people, and courses of study - to tie up loose ends around your home and in other areas of your life. It could also signify some kind of celebration...such as the successful outcome of something you have been working towards. Perhaps if you stay in [REDACTED], a brand new 'world' will open up right where you are - or maybe you will get the opportunity to travel. Although this card does urge you to bring your life in [REDACTED] (or whatever you are currently doing in [REDACTED]) to a close.

### What will happen if you move?

The Ace of Cups is a wonderful card of new beginnings. ☺ This is a card of love and anticipation and signals a brand new start on an emotional level and of new romantic relationships. It suggests you will be surrounded by (and may even fall in) love if you move - as well as experience a surge of creativity. Some Tarot readers describe this card as a "tide of bliss awaiting you"! And it definitely recommends that you 'follow your bliss' and go after your dreams. Also, the Ace of Cups rules all the astrological water-signs (Cancer/Scorpio/Pisces) which would relate to a new start at the seaside.

### Advice

The Hanged Man is about letting go of the ego and the need to control everything. He says: "Don't worry, be happy"! But also suggests you will need to 'sacrifice' something in order to move. His advice is to 'hang loose' and detach yourself from any problems as they are only temporary. Things are in a state of transition and this card advises looking at your situation from a different perspective. (He is upside down, after all). And then to wait. And trust the universe. Things may not get sorted immediately, in fact there may well be a period of 'waiting' involved. But if you can detach your mind from worrying

about the details by focusing on the bigger picture instead, everything *will* work out. He's also ruled by Pisces, just like you!

## Outcome

The [Eight of Cups](#) in the 'outcome' position would suggest that you are moving. This is THE moving card – not by air or sea, but overland – so this usually means relocation to a different part of the country. A move you make from a deep desire to get away from where you are, to something better. Although there's also a whiff of sacrifice about this. As if you've been drained emotionally by giving so much of your energy and support to others - and that it's now time to take care of yourself. It's ruled by Pisces, which again is YOU, so I definitely feel you will somehow 'come into yourself' if you move.

## Conclusion:

It certainly feels like it's a good decision to move. Especially to the seaside. As this move will make you happy both emotionally and creatively – and quite possibly help you find true love. 😊

**In terms of timing,** Cups correspond to summer – and The Ace of Cups to Midsummer's Day – so possibly next summer. Although I don't see anything happening in a rush. There are things you need to tie up first. And also something to 'let go' of, (a person/belief/problem that isn't really a problem?) You will know what it is.

Although... It *might* be that giving up 'whatever it is' may feel to you like too much of a sacrifice. {*But is it worth sacrificing your own happiness for?*} Only you can make that decision.

Once you *have* made the decision and laid things to rest in [REDACTED], you will be able to move on. And I don't feel you need to worry about the details – once you put things in motion regarding the move, it will be easier than you think. Have faith in the universe!
